The Vermejo Park Ranch Definition of a Management Bull Elk

A Management bull elk at Vermejo is generally a mature bull elk with one or both pedicels damaged due to physical or genetic causes that results in an obvious deformity of one or both antlers. Some older 5X5 bulls also qualify as management bulls. The guide will make the final call whether the bull qualifies for harvest. Obviously young bulls, young symmetrical 5X5s or large non-typical bulls are not considered management bulls. Management bulls generally have lower B&C scores (our average since 2014 is 254) but tend to have a lot of "character". Our management bull elk hunt is one of our most difficult in terms of harvest success. You will see many bulls but only a few will qualify as management bulls, then you still have to make a good shot. Our management bull hunt success rate since 2014 has been about 65% on average.

Rates

- Trophy and Premium hunts include lodging, meals, full guide service, game skinning and selected amenities available at the time of your stay.
- Late season Guided Cow elk hunts do not include meals or lodging.
- Rates do not include alcoholic beverages, Company Store purchases or customary gratuities to hospitality staff and guides.
- Unless specifically stated, meat processing is not included in the hunt fee.
- Late arrivals or early departures are subject to the full booking fee. No refunds or discounts are offered.



General Terms and Conditions

- Hunt packages on Vermejo Park Ranch are considered **"booked" when a 50% deposit** of the total price of the package is on file with our Reservations Desk.
- A grace period of 10-buisness days is allowed from the day of written or verbal request to pay the deposit to the Reservations Desk via check or credit card. An invoice will be provided if your request is accepted. Please do not attempt to pay without first receiving an invoice.
- The total hunt cost is due by July 31 of the calendar year of the hunt. March 1 for turkey hunts.
- Hunt reservations not paid in full by July 31 of the calendar year of the hunt will be canceled and resold. Hunts booked after July 31, for the same calendar year, require full payment.
- Individuals booking for multiple hunters will be required to notify in writing additional hunter names, and payment type (email is sufficient). All persons paying will be held to this deposit policy. Only those in the party who have a confirmed deposit will be booked and only those with full payment as per this policy will be granted hunting privileges.
- Hunts are not booked more than 2 years in advance and are subject to the deposit policy listed above.
- **Dates and rates are subject to change**, however, the price at the time of booking will be honored if a 50% deposit has been received.
- Exceptions to the policies listed above are made at the sole discretion of management.

Cancelations and Refunds

In the unfortunate event you must cancel your hunt, refunds of deposit are available under the following circumstances:

- Cancelations made prior to April 30: refund of deposit is available, minus a 15% administrative fee. (*January 30 for Turkey Hunts*).
- Cancellations made after April 30: 80% of deposit is available for refund if a client of similar value can be booked for the same date (*January 30 for Turkey Hunts*).
- Cancellations made after August 1: no refund of deposit is available (*March 1 for Turkey Hunts*).
- <u>Vermejo no longer transfers deposits or reservations to subsequent years. Refunds of deposit overages</u> are made at time of departure.
- Exceptions to this policy are made at the sole discretion of Vermejo Park Ranch management on a case by case basis.

Meat Processing and Taxidermy

A custom meat processor (Cinnamon Creek Wild Game Processing of Ft. Worth, TX) will be on-site during the trophy and premium hunts. They will skin/cape your trophy as part of the cost of your hunt. If you would like for them to process and ship your game meat and/or ship your hide and antlers they he can do so for an additional fee paid to the processor. They can also arrange to have your taxidermy work done at Alpine Taxidermy (Ft. Worth, TX).
